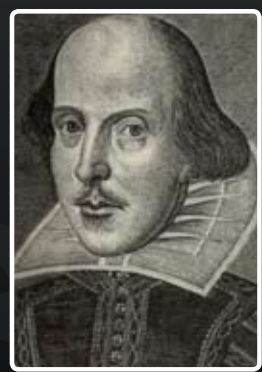
A look behind the scenes at two of its most historic houses

Following lunch you will visit one of London most historic theatres, the Old Vic, where such luminaries as Lord Laurence Olivier, Sir John Gielgud and Sir Ralph Richardson

performed. Your tour includes a donation to the Old Vic's Charitable Foundation.

The Theatres director will speak about his experience, triumphs and challenges, running one of the world's major theatrical institutions. Following the tour you will be transferred back to your hotel.
